

Document Integrity Verification

This verification relies on a SHA-256 cryptographic hash together with a timestamp proof anchored to the Bitcoin blockchain.

1. The Problem

For centuries, humanity has accumulated knowledge at an ever-increasing pace.

2. The Instinct to Explore

From the earliest human migrations to the great maritime expeditions, from the depths of the oceans to the far reaches of space, every era has been driven by the same force:

The need to explore.

This spark exists within every child.

The need to understand.

The need to discover.

It is this curiosity that inspires us to open a book, ask a question, cross a mountain, sail across an ocean, or look up at the sky.

Humanity advances when women and men choose to leave behind what they know in order to explore what they do not.

Exploration is not merely a way to acquire knowledge.

It is a mechanism rooted deep within us.

Preserve it.

3. The TRINITY QUEST Project

Trinity Quest is a global treasure hunt.

It combines:

- foundational narratives;

The project is built upon two simple principles:

Exploration comes before conclusion.

The project recognizes the value of the work carried out by researchers, authors, explorers, scientists, historians, archaeologists, journalists, institutions, and communities who contribute to the advancement of human knowledge.

The works, hypotheses, and theories encountered throughout Trinity Quest are considered opportunities for exploration and reflection. Their inclusion does not constitute either validation or refutation of their content.

Trinity Quest systematically distinguishes between observable facts, available data, formulated hypotheses, and the interpretations that arise from them.

Every participant remains free to build their own understanding, challenge their assumptions, and arrive at their own conclusions.

Respect for ideas also requires accepting their critical examination. No theory, institution, author, or work should be considered beyond debate, verification, or reasoned discussion.

Every claim should be tested against sources, evidence, and experience.

Trinity Quest does not offer a truth.

Trinity Quest offers a framework.

Explore it.

4. The Three Questions

The DNA of Trinity Quest is built around three questions.

What am I?

To identify and define the nature of an object, symbol, text, place, or idea.

Where am I?

To locate knowledge in space, connect discoveries to the real world, and understand the geography of civilizations, discoveries, and the traces left behind by humanity.

When am I?

To place events in time, understand cycles, historical contexts, and the relationships between events.

These three questions form the core of every puzzle, every quest, and every discovery.

Ask them.

5. Progress Toward the Solution

Trinity Quest is built upon distributed progression.

The solution is never given.

It is constructed gradually through observation, discovery, experimentation, and the connection of gathered information.

The resolution of the quest does not depend upon a central authority, but upon the ability of participants to explore, understand, connect, and demonstrate what they discover.

To progress, participants must mobilize a variety of skills.

Their attention must focus on the different building blocks that make up the quest.

No piece of information is considered isolated.

Every discovery may complement, confirm, or challenge the understanding of another element of the quest.

The tools provided make it possible to measure and validate this progression, ensuring that any claim to the treasure is legitimate.

They also enable participants to compare their work and contribute to the project.

The solution may be pursued collectively, but progression remains individual.

6. A World to Discover

Trinity Quest does not end at the screen.

The real world is the primary field of exploration.

It serves three functions:

- to motivate exploration;
- to guarantee the existence of a tangible objective;
- to embody the final achievement.

Its existence can be publicly verified, and its value can be estimated in real time.

Its management relies upon transparent and incorruptible mechanisms.

The treasure is not merely the end goal of the project. It is the catalyst for the entire exploration.

Although the paths leading to the treasure have already been laid out, Trinity Quest is designed to evolve.
